

Breathe Magic Intensive Therapy Programme Frequently Asked Questions for 2025

Who is the programme for?

The programme is for young people, aged 7–19 years old, who have a clinical diagnosis of hemiplegia or a predominant one-sided weakness or paralysis.

When will the camp take place?

Mon 28th Jul – Fri 8th Aug 2025.

What times are the camp days?

10am – 4pm. Apart from Day 10 (magic show day) which will be 11am – approx. 8/9pm.

Where will the camp take place?

Sea Containers London hotel.

Where will the magic show take place?

The venue is currently TBC but will be in London as close to Sea Containers London as possible.

When will I know if my child is accepted onto the programme?

We will confirm the outcome of your child's screening as soon as possible after the screening day. We may need to contact any professionals responsible for your child's care should we need to find out any further info on your child's need and if the programme is the best fit.

How much does the programme cost?

For 2025, we can offer all children taking part in the programme, who live within the UK and Northern Ireland, a Breathe part-funded place of £3,979 (subject to annual review). The full cost of a place is £6,104.

Do you provide fundraising help or bursaries?

Yes - there are several funding options that you can pursue to cover the cost of your child's place on the programme and our Head of Development will have a funding call with every family before the programme, to offer advice to guide you through this process, and support you if you are fundraising.

When will the in-person pre & post-clinical assessments take place?

Pre-camp assessments will take place across July 2025, and between 11th – 15th Aug 2025.

Where will the in-person pre & post-clinical assessments take place?

They will take place at Breathe's office in Southwark, London, or at Sea Containers London.

When will my child's assessment dates be confirmed?

Dates will be allocated approximately in Apr 2025, once we have recruited the majority of children confirmed to join this year's programme.
